

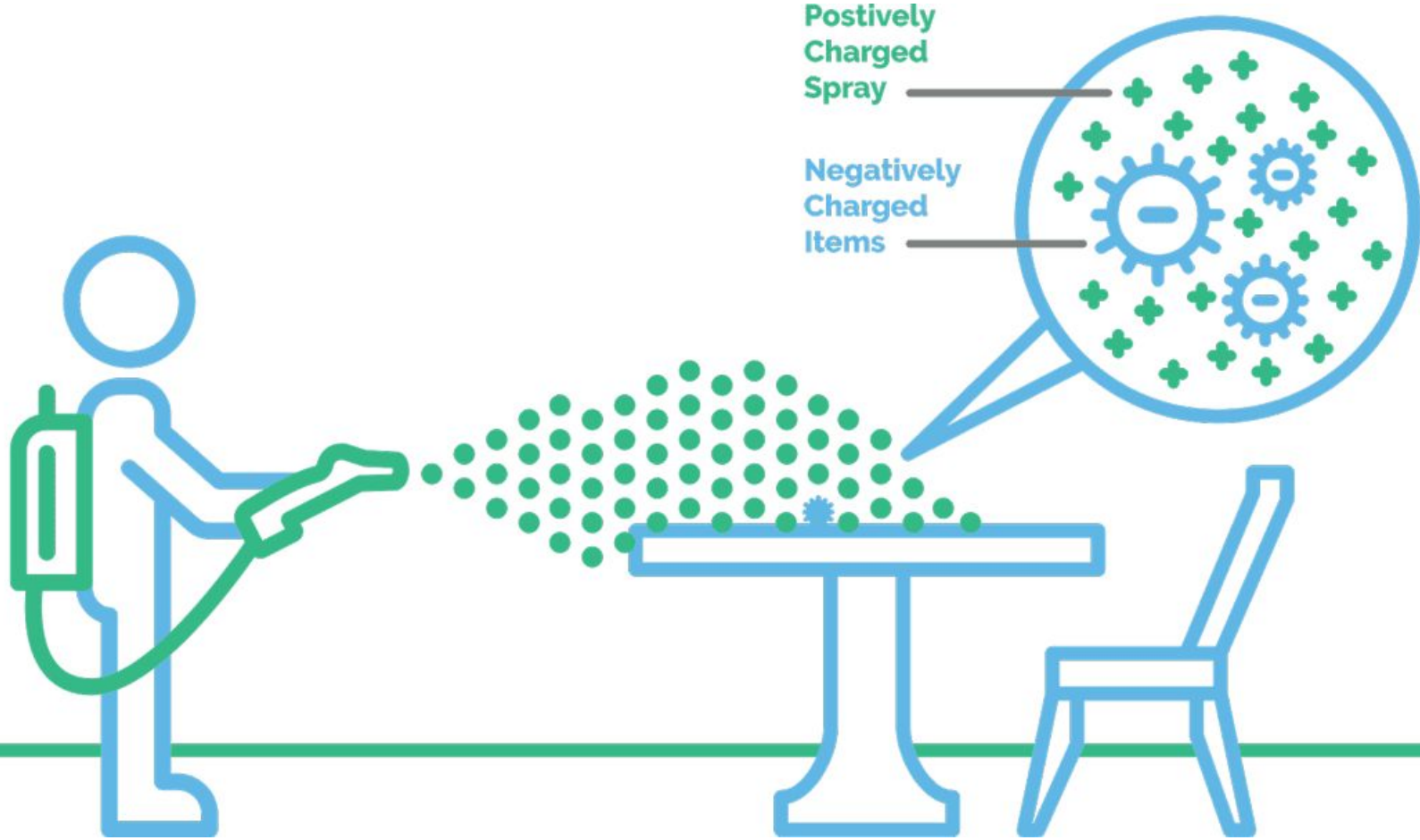

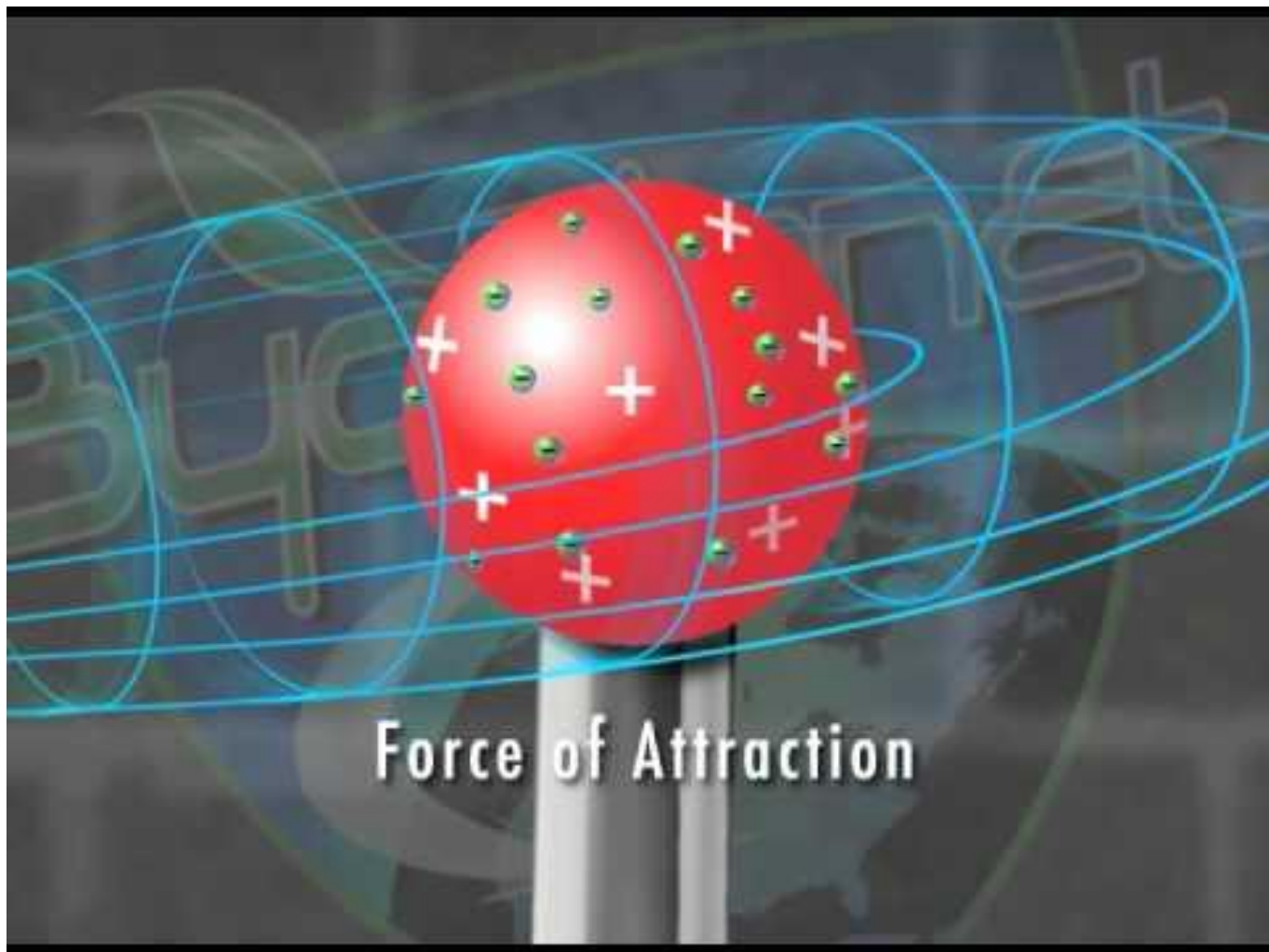
Protocols and Procedures

1. All custodians have been trained in sanitization by a manufacturer rep. from the company we get our chemicals from (Pro-Link), and have also received certified hazardous communications training (SDS, and safe chemical usage).

2. We will be using, primarily, electrostatic sprayers to sanitize school buildings.

3. The chemicals used to sanitize are Green Klean and Hypochlorous acid. Both are highly effective against SARS-COV 2 virus.

Hypochlorous Acid (HOCl)

HOCl is a powerful 100% organic disinfection antimicrobial agent that neutralizes toxins, bacteria, and inflammatory mediators.





4. We have established COVID specific protocols for bodily fluid clean up and sanitization.

- 1- The custodian responding to the spillage will don all necessary PPE, including but not limited to nitrile gloves, face mask, and eye protection (face shield or protective glasses).
- 2- A drying agent will be administered to the entirety of the spill and allowed to sit for a sufficient time to dry the liquid.
- 3- Once the fluid has been absorbed by the drying agent, the remaining drying agent will be removed.
- 4- The area where the fluid was spilled will be sprayed with a disinfecting solution which will sit for the proper dwell time for the product used.
- 5- After allowing proper dwell time, the spot where the spill occurred can be mopped. If the spill occurred on a carpet, a carpet extraction machine will be used to clean the area.
- 6- A “wet floor” sign will be placed where the spill initially occurred, and all materials used in the clean-up processes will be placed into its own trash bag and expedited to the dumpster. The responding custodian will also discard all PPE used during the clean up appropriately.

5. Primary focus for custodians will be sanitizing and disinfecting (aka infection control).

Sanitizing and Disinfecting- Focus on killing viral matter, bacterial matter, mold and fungi. Main Priority.

Cleaning- More aesthetic in nature. Secondary Priority.

All common touchpoints are being sanitized at least three times daily, as are all touchpoints in restrooms (common and secondary).

Restrooms are to be cleaned twice a day, minimally, in addition to sanitizing.

The facilities department has been tracking sanitization in buildings since October in a spreadsheet that is generated from form entries made by custodians each time sanitizing is performed.

Custodians and administrators have all received a copy of our comprehensive document outlining protocols and procedures for operating at a heightened state of awareness.
